By car...

1. MANTOUDI - DRIMONAS - MONASTERY OF ST DAVID

Starting from Mantoudi towards Agia Anna you will cross Kirinthos (locals call it as Skylogiannis too, because according to the story the Despot having a walk around the region to Ai Giannis and its chapel he was attacked by the dogs of the shepherds ripped his clothes and because of his irritation the village named so!). Continue to Strofylia in a dense pine forest overlooking the Aegean and in the 10th klm before pulling into Agia Anna you will make a detour towards the Palaiovrysi (Paliovrysi for locals). From this point by foot you can visit the canyon of Boulovinaina.

From the main road leading to Artemisio you may turn left towards Kerasia to enjoy a path between planes and pines. You may continue on the same road to reach Drimonas and enjoy the waterfalls and finally arrive at the Monastery of Saint David, built in 1500, destroyed by the Turks and rebuilt in 1877. In the chapel of St. Anargyroi you may visit the part with the cells along with the nice frescoes of 17th century.



2. STROFYLIA - LIMNI - EDIPSOS - LIHADA

Commencing from Strofylia where you can visit the church of the Holy Trinity with an elaborate iconostasis and just outside the village Byzantine three-arched bridge, you pass from Kechries, Daphne and Myrtia to end up in the picturesque city of Limni, one of the few cities of the island of Evia constructed on an island architecture which you will anyway visit during your stay in our hotel to enjoy



strolling, coffee shops, tavernas and shopping. The next stop is the village of Rovies, the ancient city of Oroviai, based on Strabo there was the oracle dedicated to Apollo the Selinunte. During your stay in our hotel you will visit the village for lunch or dineer, coffee and sweets and the beach. Still on the promenade after Kaminia at 2 km. you will turn right to visit the Monasteri of Saint Irene and then you meet Ilia, a fishing village with a nice beach. Heading to Ano Ilia after 8 km you will visit the Monastery of St. George, passing through a beautiful forest of pine trees, planes and low vegetation. In the background you can see the mountain Dirfis, the highest mountain of Evia with altitude of 1743 meters.

At the end of the route you will reach Edipsos, the famous spa town.

After leaving Edipsos and Agios Nikolaos, you will complete your route in the bay Gialtra (Yialtra), the beach of Vlycha and Mylos to end up in the bathhouse of Gialtra with its spa facilities.

Then follow the road that takes you to Gregolimano, and Agios Georgios, a fish village, and after 4 km you will reach Kavos from where you can cross over to Lihadonisia a place of outstanding natural beauty.

For the return we suggest you to visit Lihada before you take the road to your final destination of Edipsos.

3. NEOS PIRGOS - ISTIEA - ARTEMISIO - PAPADES

To visit the northern part of the island you will first go through the Neos Pargos and you will meet on your way the beach Nisiotissa. At Orei you will make a stop to see from close the Bull of Oreoi and then you will arrive at Istiea, a city where you can find banks, social and public services, super markets and the Museum of Natural History. From Istiaia we propose a detour to visit the beach Kanatadika with the known protected wetland.

Passing Asminio, a beautiful village and Pefki, the port of Artemisio with its characteristics upright pines of the Evian land you arrive at Artemisio. Then you will visit the traditional village of Gouvia with Drosini tower that today is considered one of the



village Papades lies the Dasiko Chorio (the Forest Village), an effort for alternative tourism that does not have the expected results.



1. Katounia - Troupi

You will start from Katounia, an area located at 2.5 km southeast of Limni with one stop in the beach of Agios Ioannis, a chapel drowned the planes. Having find the church of Saint George with the homonym beach just below in the distance of 3 km you reach the Galataki Monastery. From this monastery starts a forest road of 2.8 km in the pine forest and then you follow on your right, the sign pointing to Pefkeli. You must be very careful because of the cliff. At a distance of 1.8 km you will find an alley on your right which leads you to the sea. You continue to the left and after 2.3 km you reach a plateau and at a distance of 2.7 km you reach the chapel of Panagia.

best preserved towers in Evia while in Gouves you can visit the nearby beaches in the northern part of the island such as Gouves, Koutsoum-pri and Pefki.

To reach the village of Papades you will pass through a dense pine forest, olive grove and recently afforested after the fires of 1996 and the villages Elinika with its port of Agios Nikolaos and the village Vasilika with its seaport Psaropouli. In the

From this point you need to pay attention because the road becomes narrow. Below you can see the old mines of Magnesite and two man-made lakes filled with water even in summer. At 3.3 km the road continues to the right towards a small white chappel of Zodochou Pigis. Following the direction to the left and after you reach the highest point of the route (about 700 meters) you go downhill, always to the left and you will reach in 2.2 km in a water tank, in a forest of pines and firs and then a dense clump of trees over the stream. At 2.9 km you find a detour on your left. You will continue until the next parallel to this road, always towards the left at the next fork, turn left again and in 4 km you will arrive at a plateau.

Through the dense vegetation at 4.7 km the road passes over the magnesite mine and at 100 meters the road will lead you to the castle Dafnusa. At this point you can get off and walk to get to the castle.

Returning to the last junction that leads to the castle, continue straight and at 5.1 km you ignore the exit to the right that leads through the forest and ends at a dead-end street, and follow the downhill road to the right you will find the provincial road that leads to Dafnusa and at a 1.5 km you will reach the village Troupi. The distance from Limni to Troupi is 23 km.

2. Prokopi - Kalyvia Kireos

Starting from Prokopi you take the road that leads to Mantoudi and at 600 meters on the left follow the sign to Dafnusa. In the next 1.8 km right after passing gravel roads and through forests of oaks and pine trees at 200 meters on the left at the fork (there is usually a sign that says to Ai Ioannis Prodromos / St. John Baptist) you will enter into a dense vegetation than after 1.5 km you will find the church. Caution streams depending on weather conditions. After 2.9 km you will find yourself in front of two roads that go left. You follow the main road that takes you from east to west. Heading left (east) at the next fork, turn right down having on your left the stream with planes. On the road and at 1.8 km and 3.2 km you will come across another stream. At 3.5 km you come to an exit in a glade where will soon hit the road Kirinthos - Prokopi and after 1 km you will end up in Kalyvia Kireos.

3. Ilia - Kastaniotissa

It is a short path that compensates you with captivating views and vegetation.

You will follow the road that leads from Ilia to the monastery of St George of Ilion, go up and ignore the sign that takes you to the monastery



(after 1.2 km) and at 4 km starts a dirt road. You follow the road towards the left to Polylofo (400 meters) you will ignore the road that leads you to the monastery of St. George and you will reach the village Polylofo, at 5 km from the beginning of the route, a beautiful small village with old stone houses and trees on the stream.

After Polylofo follow the road to Panagia and Old Temple (Paleo Iero) with its stunning views over the large plain of Istiea that reaches down to the sea. Follow the fork to the right, ignore the next sign left to Panagia and continue straight ahead and at the 3rd km of the route it will take you to a clearing from where you can see Edipsos. Following the road always heading left ignore the next two detours on your right, in 4km from Polylofo you will find a new fork, which left leads to Agios Aidipsu while you continue clockwise and in 4.5 km you will find yourself in a glade with views across the mainland, the west coast of Evia and the tops Kalidromo. At 6.4 km you enter a beautiful plateau and then descend to a forest of beech trees and ferns to reach one of the peaks of Telethrio, called Gimno. To reach up to the top you have to walk. Going back the last junction keep left, you pass by recently felled forest, in 1 km you will find a new plateau with tree beeches and at a 2.5 km there is a steep downhill that requires attention. At 3.2 km you will reach the main dirt road and continue straight to the north and at 5.5 km and after passing through a forest you get Kastaniotissa, a mountainous village at an altitude of 320 meters surrounded by chestnut. Total path from Ilia to Kastaniotissa : 18 km.

4. Vlycha - Pantermos Beach

Starting from the beach of Vlycha towards Lihada from the promenade of the bay of Gialtra and just before the road turns to the east you will find a side street and 800 meters at the intersection. Continue to the right on the gravel road. In 3km in reforested pine wood you will encounter on your right the twin church of Panagia. In half a kilometer turn right and in continuity the road becomes passable and following right the first street to the left you will reach the beach Pantermos.



Lihada - top of mountain Lichas

Duration (hours): 1.50

Difficulty Level : 1

From the central square of Lichada climb the road to the right of the church for 500m. where you find the church of Agios Athanasios (alt. 330m). Following the dirt road heading northeast at 35° you arrive in Vigla (alt. 380m). Here begins a path that takes you to Kratidia and the beautiful beach of Agapitos after 1.5 hours. You continue uphill the dirt road and in 5', at Agios Jason you find the path on your right, leading after 200m. at a source. By taking left the trail grow again you find yourself on the gravel road. By walking on your left you can see the Mount Othris, the Pelasgia, the beaches of Magnesia and the narrow channel that connects the Maliakos Gulf with the Aegean. After walking 25 minutes we reach the position Achladeri, you follow the path on the right direction. In 35 minutes you reach the summit of Mount Lichas where the small church of Prophet Elias (alt. 675m). A panoramic view to the beautiful beaches of Lichadas and Fthiotida, Lihadonisia, Kallidromo in front of you.



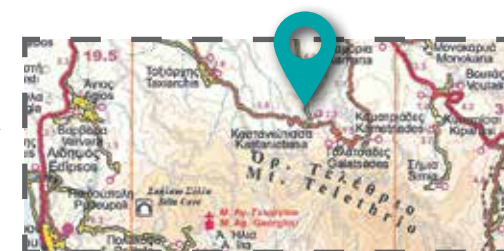
Kastaniotissa – Semia (Telethrio)

Duration (hours): 4.00

Difficulty Level: 1

Northern Evia includes two main massifs mountainous, the mountain Toelethrio (969 m.) and the mountain Xiros (990 m.)

From Kastaniotissa at the end of the main



road (alt. 310m) starts the beautiful Telethrio. At the end of the main street you may go left 100m. and follow the dirt road at your right hand. Following the dirt road towards the NW and W for 2 km, you will find the church of Panagia (alt. 532m). After the chapel at 1 km turn right (alt. 635m), pay attention to the signals, because there are many intersections. After 500 meters (altitude 705m) you find the intersection of three roads. The left road goes downhill to Galatsiades, on your right leads in 1 km to the aqueduct of Galatsades. You proceed straight uphill following the yellow signals. If you continue the course straight, after 600 meters you will reach the position Filakio (Outpost) (altitude 740m), where you take the left dirt road. Walking about 700 meters you reach a col (named Gourni Litharia, alt. 760m) and continue straight to a beautiful landscape. Then you meet two other crosses 400m (alt. 765m) and 1.1 km (alt. 845m). You proceed straight towards SE. At 1.9 km from the last intersection you reach the top of Telethrio (alt. 970m), and there is the church of the Prophet Elijah (Elias). From here you gaze throughout North Evia and Pagasitikos. The distance from our starting point is 8,2 km. Follow the dirt road and after 6.5 km or 1.5 hours through the forest you reach Telethrio Simia (alt. 440m), where the path ends. The route is ideal for mountain biking too.

Kourkouli-top Mountain Xiros

Duration (hours): 3:00

Difficulty Level: 1

From the square of the village Kourkouli (alt. 415m) move uphill right next to the church for 15 minutes and you find the road. On your right the path leads you to the mountain Xiros. After walking 15 minutes you see the shrine of St. Demetrios. At this point you leave the road on the left and follow the anti firewall for 20' and you reach a junction. You take the left dirt road watching the white-red signals and a 15' you



reach a ravine (Palaiochori, alt. 535m). Right from the source moving alongside the stream uphill, you pass drilling on your left (alt. 565m) and after 20 minutes you cross the road and follow the path left of the sheepfold. After walking 20 minutes to trail and dirt road you reach the position Moulakotopos (alt. 680m). From this point you continue uphill in a prominently marked path at 20' and you meet Ardalona, old threshing floors. Follow for 10' the signs, cross the road (alt. 812m) and continue uphill on the path beneath fir trees, oak-trees and maples. Overtaking two large rocks encountered (alt. 856m) and 40' you reach the point that from your right starts the Mikro Luki of the Mountain Xiros (alt.

916m). After 30 minutes you reach the peak (alt. 990m), from where you can gaze Dirfi, Pixaria, Kantili, Telethrio, Lihada Pelion, the islands of Sporades. You can continue until the waterfalls of Drymonas.

Waterfalls Drymonas - Mountain Xiros

Duration (hours): 3.30

Difficulty Level: 1

In Rovies, on the main road to Edipsos, turn right at the intersection to the Monastery of Saint David. In a distance of 12 km. and after you pass the Abbey and the villages Paliohori, Damia, Kalamoudi, Drymonas, you arrive at the waterfalls Drymonas. At the entrance of the trail to the falls there is a wooden plaque of Forestry of the city of Limni. The trail is steep and it takes 10 minutes or so to reach the large waterfall. After the waterfall the trail continues and in 5', you go out to the main asphalt road. At this point there is a wooden house (alt. 660m). The trail to the top of the Mountain Xiron begins from the asphalt road, opposite to the outpost. Initially the trail is easy and with little slope. After walking about 15 minutes crosses the forest road which goes left. After 300 meters the trail continues on the right side of the road. Heading east and after 200m. approximately you arrive at the plateau. In front of you there is a dirt road which is not entering. Turn on the plateau right following the signals posed on trees. The path now becomes more steep at some points. The pine forest is dense and occasionally you find large trees, oak-trees and maples. The trail continues through the woods until it meets a forest road (created for logging), which you follow for some time until the end (all the way there are red-white metal marks upon the trees). From this point where the road ends the lumberjacks to the top is about 15'. The trail leaves the forest, continues for 300 meters approximately over the ridge on bare limestone and ends at the top. The top lies at an altitude of 990m. and from here you have a panoramic view of the relief of Central Evia and the islands of Skiathos and Skopelos. If the atmosphere is clear you can see up and Mount Athos.



Crossing Gorge Neleus (Nigger)

Duration (hours): 2:00

Difficulty Level: 1

From the village Keramia you continue the asphalt road to Agia Anna. After walking 3 km. there is a downhill road (main street) to your left leading to the entrance of the

trail. The dirt road is signaled with signals - white box with red center - and arrows in order to prevent your entrance into the wrong forest road. After walking one km. the road reaches a plateau, where you leave the car. Here are signs and arrows that guide your entry to the trail, which in turn takes you down the riverbed Neleus. The trail goes through lush vegetation comprising gorse, oaks, wild pistachio trees, pines, etc. At some points the trail has great views of the canyon from above. After 20 minutes or so downhill path you reach the riverbed where a few meters ahead is the entrance to the gorge. Your course from here is pointing north and into the water. The entrance to the gorge of Neleus is impressive. At this point the gorge is very narrow and its height reaches about 50 meters. In many parts of the huge monoliths that have fallen create type roof and the sun hardly shines the riverbed. In order to cross the gorge of Neleus you need swimwear, because many points have to swim in deep water over one meter. The gorge of the entrance to the concrete bridge of Amelanton, length 1.400m. and takes about two hours to one crossed slowly. From Amelanton bridge is 2 km uphill forest road, which leads to the plateau where you have left your car. You may run its course in the river for another 3.5 km. and go out after 5 hours route around the village of Kerasia.



Mount Kantili, Saint - Roumpakia - Kourvelo

Duration (hours): 7:30

Difficulty Level: 2

At the point Agios (altitude 665m.) of the National Road Halkida-Istiea turn left on the gravel road (coming from Halkida) and after 7 km. you reach the corral of Vavoulioti, from where begins the beautiful but unknown to most people route, the crossing of Mount Kandili. (This route of 7 km. better be done by car, the road is passable). Left out of the corral Vavoulioti (alt. 700m.) you find a marked visible path, follow it and after 15-20 minutes at an altitude of 800 meters turn left to the road. After 100-150m. you get back to your path that is left. In 20'-30' you reach the base of the first peak-Pirgaki 1.087m. Beware of signs because of dense vegetation. One hour and half later you reach the second peak Roupakia 1.207m. Again grab the path from the base of the summit ridge and proceed the ridge by having left the Evian Gulf and on your right the villages of north central Evia and some great views. You walk at an altitude of 1,055 - 1,000 meters and in 45



minutes you reach the base of the peak Kourvelo. From there, relatively difficult, after about one hour you reach the peak at 1.225m. The path length from the pen of Vavoulioti to the top Kourvelo is about 6.5 km.

Troupa - Strougkitsa (Kantili)

Duration: 3.30

Difficulty Level: 2

Traveling on the National Road Chalkida-Mantoudi, about 700 m. after Prokopi, encounter left the junction leading to the villages Dafne, Troupi, Kalyvia at the foot of Mount Kantili. After 7.3 km. on a paved road you reach Troupi. The path to the top Strougkitsa starts from the church of Agia Triada and ascends SW in a beautiful forest of pines and plane trees with good signage. The segmented path crosses the dirt road. In 40' you find the place Selina (alt. 500m), a source with the aqueduct. Continuing the route of firs and beautiful views of the Aegean and the Sporades, you arrive at 35' in a col (alt. 680m). From here it is visible the Evoikos Gulf. The route continues to the left uphill and in 20' you find on your right the base of the plane tree Kali Pigi (Good Source) and the church of Zodochos Pigi (alt. 780m). Walking 700m. you meet the dirt road right (alt. 790m) and the marked path. Following carefully the signages that lead you to the top. After walking 50' you reach the position Agnanti (alt. 1.000m) with panoramic views of the Aegean. From here also you gaze the villages of North. Evia. Continuing for 30' you meet the Passage of Chrisaetos (Golden eagles) (alt. 1.180m), where you need a little climbing to get to the top (alt. 1.245m). The compensation for your effort and sweat is the amazing view. The view takes us 360 degrees from the Aegean to the Evian Golf, meets the mountains of Evia (Dirfys, Xirovouni, Evoikos Olympos, Ktipas, Xiron, Telethrio, Lihada) and ends in the remaining vertices of Kandili (Drakotourla, Kouvero, Roumpakia, Pyrgaki) crossing is a challenge for the few daring. The return by the same route to enjoy more relaxed the beautiful view stretches at your feet.



Pili - Pixarias

Duration (hours): 1.45

Difficulty Level: 1

From the square of Pelion (alt. 25 meters) after 700m walking NW, on the left you find a

small shrine and across a sheepfold. At this point begins on your left the steep path and in ten minutes you find the road that leads to the church of Panagia. You proceed uphill on the road, having on your left the ravine. The creek is a small canyon with fantastic compositions created by rocks and wounded-regenerated trees from the fire of 1997. Continuing on the dirt road for 10 minutes, you reach the cool spring Platani and after a further 10', leave the dirt road and cross the stream where there is another source.



You continue the trail marked 15' and encounter the iconostasis of the Saints Taxiarches. You cross the dirt road and proceed towards the hill on the steep path after path 10' encounter another dirt road. You follow the direction for another 10' and you find on your left the path. From here you can admire the mountains of Kantil and Xiron, Psili Rachi, Pili, the Sporades and the other slopes of Pixaria. Continuing on the path and after crossing the road you encounter, you get in 15' the chapel of Prophet Elias. Moving on to the dirt road for 10 minutes, you reach Karya with the aqueduct and the source. The view is fantastic with huge trees and the picturesque chapel of Saint Irene (alt. 466m). Behind the church on the other side of the road on your left and follow the path through the pines you reach in 15 minutes the place Mnimio (Monument) (alt. 535m).

Vlachia - Pixaria (Peak 1.352 m)

Duration (hours): 6.00

Difficulty Level: 2

You start from the square of Vlachia (alt. 170 m) you take the southwest path to get to the beginning of the beautiful trail that leads to the top (alt 610m). The route is 3.5 km long and can be done by car in 10' and by walk in 1 hour (road end). You continue uphill SW and after about 40' you reach a col (alt.



820m). You continue having on your left the Aegean right after 20' you find the source (alt. 910m). From here in 15 minutes you arrive at a path junction (alt. 920m). Attention, from this point you must ascend right, constantly seeing the signs. Through Pixaria, relatively difficult, after 1 hour and 50' you reach the first peak (alt. 1 326m). Following the ridge 10-15' you are at the highest peak of Pixaria (1.352 m.). The way back through the same route is about 2.5 hours.





1. Limni

It is a series of small beaches that follow the lace embossed land.

2. Katounia - Agios Georgios

Beautiful bay with spectacular sunset and a source with gurgling water.

3. Rovies

The beach in Rovies is the sequel to the sea, the homonymous coastal village in North Evvoia. It is one of the most famous beaches, pebble and sand both the entrance and the bottom.

It has several points organized with sunbeds and umbrellas and coffeeshops. Along the beach there are several taverns where you can enjoy your food and coffee. For your supplies from the village. It is worthwhile also to visit the following beaches belonging to Rovies: Beach Hercules, one of the most beautiful Rovies beaches located immediately after the village towards, Limni with its characteristic feature of the rich vegetation. Olive Beach / River quietly with nice spot around the mouth of the small river "Gerakas". Beaches Ampouria, Kamini and the Camps of Taxiarchis, located in a very quiet and picturesque place towards Edipsos.

4. Beach Ilia - Bay Monastery

Organized narrow beach with several dining and coffee shops.

5. Beach Agios Nikolaos Edipsos

A narrow beach with sand and pebbles wide busy because it is located very close to the main road.

6. St. George (Gialtra)

Quiet beach with many sailboats as the port of Agios Konstantinos is located six miles

south of the region.

7. Beach Agios Georgios

One of the most beautiful beaches of Evia, Agios Georgios is situated in front of the village Agios Georgios. A beach with long coastline with fine and coarse gravel. The name of St George due to the homonymous church, is built in the place of an old hermitage. An ideal holiday destination, with a picturesque harbor and many small beaches along, offers activities including fishing, short sea cruises, surfing, diving.

8. Kavos

A very large beach with quiet waters and a row of eucalyptus trees offers many places for food and coffee and a starting point to visit Lihadonisia.

9. Lihadonisia

A group of small islands, the largest is Stroggili and Magnolia and little smaller islands like the Little Stroggili, Steno, Vagia and some even smaller called Pontikonisia. These islands are an excellent destination for a day excursions and explorations.

10. Neos Pirgos Istieas

An organized beach with thick sand and small park of pine trees for shade and picnic.

11. Kanatadika Istieas

The continuity of the environmental protected lagoon. The beach is sandy and the road reaches the longest point.

12. Pefki

Perhaps the best organized and largest beach of northern Evia with an area of 4-5 kilometers. The beach has tall sand, pebbles, and small stones.

13. Gouves

A narrow beach on the left side of a street that leads to several natural terraces. Summer camping is free with many mobile homes.

14. Koutsoumpri (Agriovotano)

A quiet bay with beach of turquoise waters and beautiful seabed. Ideally to approach the place by boat and by car.

15. Platanias

The path through the pine forest is magical and leads to nice shady sides with coarse pebbles

16. Psaropouli Vasilikon

A very long beach with sand and pebbles with several places for lunch and coffee shops.

17. Agia Anna (Agali)

Also called Agali (hug), perhaps because it embraces in a unique way all your senses when you are there. It is the longest beach of Evia (about 9 km) and is located on the road to Istiaia. It is sandy, with beautiful waters, and high reputation because of the camping located there.

18. The beach of Kria Vrissi

The beach of Kria Vrissi is a pretty long beach in Northern Evia that could be considered the southern extension of the beach of Agia Anna. Near the beach you will find cafes and fish taverns. Many people prefer the beach for free camping.

19. Kymasi - Bay Mantoudi

An interesting beach with thick sand, beautiful monoliths in the sea and a unique fiord that offers shelter to fishing boats.

20. Makris Gialos (Vlachia)

Makris Gialos is the largest beach of

Vlachia. A stream that rolls the waters of the sea and the trees that reach the edge of the beach create a peaceful spot ideal for family attendance.

21. Sarakiniko Beach

Its name comes from pirates who had settled there. A beach with relatively difficult access which leads through a beautiful route from Prokopi with direction to Peli just after the beach of Vlachia.



The stone lighthouses in Noth Evia



1. STROGGILI LIGHTHOUSE

In the northern Evian Gulf, between Kamena Vourla and Evia, there is a series of green islands and islets, the Lihadonisia and the largest of the islands is called Stroggili. At the top of the island a stone lighthouse dominates the place. The lighthouse was built in 1870 by the French Company of Lighthouses. The altitude of tower is 9 meters and the height of focal plane is 41 meters. It emits two flashes every 10 seconds white or red depending on the direction. Since 1870 when it was built until some years ago, the island inhabited by lighthouse keepers and caretakers who took care of the lighthouse and its operation. Today it has been automated and rarely visited by anyone, mainly government agencies for maintenance of facilities.



2. VASILINA LIGHTHOUSE

After a coastal route from Kavos we find the area of Vasilina. Here is the lighthouse of Vasilina in the cape of Vasilina. The lighthouse was built in 1892. The altitude of tower is 8 meters and the height of focal plane is 10 meters.

3. ARGYRONISOS LIGHTHOUSE

The Argyronisos island with an area of about 59.3 acres located between Evia and the mainland, on the edge of the northern entrance of Orei, opposite to the entrance of

Pagasitikos. On the small island at the eastern end, there is a lighthouse built in 1899. It is a white flashing with period 5 seconds, focal height of 35 meters and a rated luminescence 16 nautical miles. The height of the cylindrical tower is 6 meters and the height of focal plane is 35 meters. Initially worked with oil, while in the years of the Occupation remained off. It reopened in 1944 as Monitored and recently has been automated by replacing kerosene with solar energy.

Now works with solar systems and is fully automated. In 2001 it was designated by the Ministry of Culture as a historic monument and has been restored. Access to the lighthouse by boat from Glyfa and Agios Dimitrios or from the side of northern Evia from Kanatadika.



4. PONTIKONISSI LIGHTHOUSE

The lighthouse was built in 1907. The height of the tower is 19 meters and the height of focal plane is 62 meters. It is established on a rocky islet, deserted, bare and arid in NE Cape of Artemisio. This lighthouse is A! class, one of the best of the Greek Lighthouse Network. It is the only mixed lighthouse projects consistent white light for free navigation. It turns on/off with white light for reef Leftheris between Skiathos Magnesia and red for Skiathos reefs.
